



The Research Center for Environmental Economics at Heidelberg University is looking to appoint a

Postdoctoral Researcher (TVL E13, up to 100%)

as soon as possible for a duration of up to six years.

The applicant should have recently completed or be about to complete a Ph.D. in economics with a specialization in environment, climate change, or natural resources.

The position is about 75% research, 25% teaching.

The applicant's research should be of the highest quality and publishable in the leading field journals in environmental economics and in good general journals of the economics profession. As postdoctoral researcher, the postholder will have the opportunity to conduct independent research in their respective field. In addition, they are expected to interact with other researchers in the RCEE and the Department of Economics. The RCEE has particular research strengths at the intersection of applied theory and experimental economics and preference will be given to candidates with a research profile that adds to the existing strengths of the unit. It is expected that the postholder will contribute to grant applications and will develop own initiative in securing external research funding.

Teaching obligations are no more than 4 hours per week during term time. The postholder will also be responsible for examination logistics and other teaching-related administration.

Salaries are according to the German pay scale E13 and range from about €50.000 to about €57.000 € per year, with extensive public sector benefits.

The successful candidates should hold or be about to receive a PhD in economics or a closely related field. Fluency in written and spoken English and German is required.

As an equal opportunity employer, the University of Heidelberg actively encourages applications from women. Preference will be given to disabled applicants with equal qualifications.

The RCEE brings together considerable expertise in environmental economics. The Department of Economics has an experimental laboratory and an active group of researchers in experimental and behavioral economics, see <https://www.awilab.de/>
